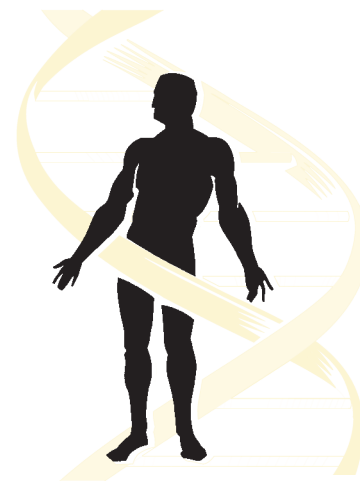

- African American men in San Mateo County had almost twice the rate of prostate cancer as that of Asian or Hispanic males, and 1.5 times that of white males from 1995 – 1999.
- Doctors recommend an annual exam for men age 40+.
- Unfortunately, African American men die needlessly because of their reluctance to get their annual exam.
